

# 5<sup>th</sup> Annual IE Doctoral Consortium

18 May 2018, Madrid

## Online Submission opens from 15 December 2017

IE Business School would shortly start accepting applications for the 5<sup>th</sup> Annual IE Doctoral Consortium to be held in Madrid, Spain, on 18 May 2018. Held for doctoral students every year, the event provides a unique platform for sharing research, obtaining feedback from leading scholars and networking with participants from IE and other top business schools. Since 2014, the Doctoral Consortium has consistently grown in size with submissions from institutions in Europe and Asia Pacific. Last year, the event received 145 applications from doctoral students across 8 countries. The 2018 edition aims to expand our growing legacy – by sparking in-depth research exchange as well as providing students with insights on the emerging paradigms of research, teaching and service in Europe and the U.S.

We welcome inter-disciplinary work using new methodologies. The potential areas for submission include Strategy, Entrepreneurship, Organizational Behavior/Human Resources, Marketing, Operations Management, Information Systems, Accounting and Management Control and Finance. The consortium would be conducted in two parts: (a) Plenary session and (b) Parallel tracks for specific disciplines.

## **Guidelines for Abstract Submission**

- 1. You are required to prepare the following for your online submission
  - One-page Curriculum Vitae (in PDF format only)
  - Short abstract of maximum 250 words (1800 characters with spaces).
  - Extended abstract (single-spaced, Times New Roman, 12-point type, left-aligned, and in PDF format only) of no more than 1000 words. Extended abstract should follow the naming convention: SPECIALIZATION\_SURNAME\_FIRST NAME (e.g. STRATEGY\_ANDERSON\_DAVID)
- 2. To qualify, it is necessary that the research work is ongoing and not published.

Applicants not adhering to these guidelines will be <u>automatically disqualified</u>. All submissions will be reviewed by the IE Doctoral Consortium Committee comprising Prof. Julio de Castro, Prof. Elena Revilla and Prof. Laura Maguire.

## **Travel Grants**

IE will offer Travel Grants to selected applicants to assist them in defraying a portion of their costs of attending the Doctoral Consortium. More details on travel grant application would be provided soon.
